INTRODUCTION

This document (the "**GUIDELINE**") is to be used as a guideline with regard to the composition, calculation and maintenance Solactive Gold Plus 7–10Y US Treasury Stacked Index (the "Index"). Any amendments to the rules made to the GUIDELINE are approved by the INDEX COMMITTEE specified in Section 3.5. The INDEX is owned, calculated, administered and published by Solactive AG ("**SOLACTIVE**") assuming the role as administrator (the "**INDEX ADMINISTRATOR**") within the meaning of the Principles for Financial Benchmarks published by the International Organization of Securities Commissions in July 2013. The name "Solactive" is trademarked.

The GUIDELINE and the policies and methodology documents referenced herein contain the underlying principles and rules regarding the structure and operation of the INDEX. SOLACTIVE does not offer any explicit or tacit guarantee or assurance, neither pertaining to the results from the use of the INDEX nor the level of the INDEX at any certain point in time nor in any other respect. SOLACTIVE strives to the best of its ability to ensure the correctness of the calculation. There is no obligation for SOLACTIVE – irrespective of possible obligations to issuers – to advise third parties, including investors and/or financial intermediaries, of any errors in the INDEX. 1. INDEX SPECIFICATIONS

1.1. SCOPE OF THE INDEX

The INDEX strategy is a multi-asset index that is designed to track, on a combined basis, 100% of the daily performance of the Solactive US 7–10 Year Treasury Bond Index (Total Return) and 100% of the daily performance of the Solactive Future Series 5-Day Roll Gold Excess Return USD Index. The INDEX is denominated in USD.

1.2. IDENTIFIERS AND PUBLICATION

The INDEX is published under the following identifiers:

*TR means that the Index is calculated as total return.

The INDEX is published on the website of the INDEX ADMINISTRATOR (www.solactive.com) and is, in addition, available via the price marketing services of Boerse Stuttgart GmbH and may be distributed to all of its affiliated vendors. Each vendor decides on an individual basis as to whether it will distribute or display the INDEX via its information systems.

Any publication in relation to the INDEX (e.g. notices, amendments to the GUIDELINE) will be available at the website of the INDEX ADMINISTRATOR: <https://www.solactive.com/news/announcements/>.

1.3. INITIAL LEVEL OF THE INDEX

The initial level of the INDEX on the 2009-01-30, the START DATE, is 10000. The INDEX ADMINISTRATOR may change the initial level of the INDEX after the START DATE, provided that no financial instrument, financial product or investment fund is linked to the INDEX at the time of such change and no financial instrument, financial product or investment fund was linked to the INDEX at any time after the START DATE. The INDEX ADMINISTRATOR may also adjust published historical INDEX levels, including back tested INDEX levels, on the basis of the changed initial level of the INDEX. Historical values from the 2026-07-14, the LIVE DATE, will be recorded. Levels of the INDEX published for a period prior to the LIVE DATE have been back-tested.



1.4. PRICES AND CALCULATION FREQUENCY

The level of the INDEX is calculated on each CALCULATION DAY from 9:00 a.m. to 4:53 p.m. EST based on the levels calculated and published by Solactive for the INDEX COMPONENTS.

In addition to the intraday calculation a closing level of the INDEX for each CALCULATION DAY is also calculated. This closing level is based on the CLOSING PRICES for the INDEX COMPONENTS.

1.5. LICENSING

Licenses to use the INDEX as the underlying value for financial instruments, investment funds and financial contracts may be issued to stock exchanges, banks, financial services providers and investment houses by SOLACTIVE.



2. INDEX SELECTION

The INDEX is composed of the following underlying components (each of them being an INDEX COMPONENT):

CALCULATION OF THE INDEX

2.1. INDEX CLOSING LEVEL

On each CALCULATION DAY t , the index is calculated according to.

$$Index_t = Index_{t-1} * \left(1 + \frac{CP1_t}{CP1_{t-1}} - 1 + \frac{CP2_t}{CP2_{t-1}} - 1 \right)$$

$CP1_t$: The CLOSING PRICE of INDEX COMPONENT 1 as of CALCULATION DAY t

$CP2_t$: The CLOSING PRICE of INDEX COMPONENT 2 as of CALCULATION DAY t

$CP1_{t-1}$: The CLOSING PRICE of INDEX COMPONENT 1 as of CALCULATION DAY $t-1$

$CP2_{t-1}$: The CLOSING PRICE of INDEX COMPONENT 2 as of CALCULATION DAY $t-1$

In the case that one of the INDEX COMPONENTS does not have a CLOSING PRICE as of any CALCULATION DAY, then the latest available CLOSING PRICE is used on that CALCULATION DAY.



2.2. ACCURACY

The level of the INDEX will be rounded to 2 decimal places for publication.

2.3. RECALCULATION

SOLACTIVE makes the greatest possible efforts to accurately calculate and maintain its indices. However, errors in the determination process may occur from time to time for variety reasons (internal or external) and therefore, cannot be completely ruled out. SOLACTIVE endeavors to correct all errors that have been identified within a reasonable period of time. The understanding of “a reasonable period of time” as well as the general measures to be taken are generally depending on the underlying and is specified in the Solactive Correction Policy, which is incorporated by reference and available on the SOLACTIVE website: <https://www.solactive.com/documents/correction-policy/>.

2.4. MARKET DISRUPTION

In periods of market stress SOLACTIVE calculates its indices following predefined and exhaustive arrangements as described in the Solactive Disruption Policy, which is incorporated by reference and available on the SOLACTIVE website: <https://www.solactive.com/documents/disruption-policy/>. Such market stress can arise due to a variety of reasons, but generally results in inaccurate or delayed prices for one or more INDEX COMPONENTS. The determination of the INDEX may be limited or impaired at times of illiquid or fragmented markets and market stress.



3. MISCELLANEOUS

3.1. DISCRETION

Any discretion which may need to be exercised in relation to the determination of the INDEX (for example the determination of the INDEX UNIVERSE (if applicable), the selection of the INDEX COMPONENTS (if applicable) or any other relevant decisions in relation to the INDEX) shall be made in accordance with strict rules regarding the exercise of discretion or expert judgement.

3.2. METHODOLOGY REVIEW

The methodology of the INDEX is subject to regular review, at least annually. In case a need of a change of the methodology has been identified within such review (e.g. if the underlying market or economic reality has changed since the launch of the INDEX, i.e. if the present methodology is based on obsolete assumptions and factors and no longer reflects the reality as accurately, reliably and appropriately as before), such change will be made in accordance with the Solactive Methodology Policy, which is incorporated by reference and available on the SOLACTIVE website: <https://www.solactive.com/documents/methodology-policy/>.

Such change in the methodology will be announced on the SOLACTIVE website under the Section "Announcements" which is available at <https://www.solactive.com/news/announcements/>. The date of the last amendment of this INDEX is contained in this GUIDELINE.

3.3. CHANGES IN CALCULATION METHOD

The application by the INDEX ADMINISTRATOR of the method described in this document is final and binding. The INDEX ADMINISTRATOR shall apply the method described above for the composition and calculation of the INDEX. However, it cannot be excluded that the market environment, supervisory, legal and financial or tax reasons may require changes to be made to this method. The INDEX ADMINISTRATOR may also make changes to the terms and conditions of the INDEX and the method applied to calculate the INDEX that it deems to be necessary and desirable in order to prevent obvious or demonstrable error or to remedy, correct or supplement incorrect terms and conditions. The INDEX ADMINISTRATOR is not obliged to provide information on any such modifications or changes. Despite the modifications and changes, the INDEX ADMINISTRATOR will take the appropriate steps to ensure a calculation method is applied that is consistent with the method described above.



3.4. TERMINATION

SOLACTIVE makes the greatest possible efforts to ensure the resilience and continued integrity of its indices over time. Where necessary, SOLACTIVE follows a clearly defined and transparent procedure to adapt Index methodologies to changing underlying markets (see Section 5.2 “Methodology Review”) in order to maintain continued reliability and comparability of the indices. Nevertheless, if no other options are available the orderly cessation of the INDEX may be indicated. This is usually the case when the underlying market or economic reality, which an index is set to measure or to reflect, changes substantially and in a way not foreseeable at the time of inception of the index, the index rules, and particularly the selection criteria, can no longer be applied coherently or the index is no longer used as the underlying value for financial instruments, investment funds and financial contracts.

SOLACTIVE has established and maintains clear guidelines on how to identify situations in which the cessation of an index is unavoidable, how stakeholders are to be informed and consulted and the procedures to be followed for a termination or the transition to an alternative index. 3.5. OVERSIGHT

An index committee composed of staff from SOLACTIVE and its subsidiaries (the “INDEX COMMITTEE”) is responsible for decisions regarding any amendments to the rules of the INDEX. Any such amendment, which may result in an amendment of the GUIDELINE, must be submitted to the INDEX COMMITTEE for prior approval and will be made in compliance with the Methodology Policy, which is available on the SOLACTIVE website: <https://www.solactive.com/documents/methodology-policy/>.



4. DEFINITIONS

"CALCULATION DAY" is any day on which either of the two INDEX COMPONENTS is scheduled to publish a CLOSING PRICE.

The "CLOSING PRICE" in respect of an INDEX COMPONENT and a CALCULATION DAY is an INDEX COMPONENTS final regular-hours closing level as calculated by Solactive.

"GUIDELINE" shall have the meaning as defined in Section "Introduction".

"INDEX" shall have the meaning as defined in Section "Introduction".

"INDEX ADMINISTRATOR" shall have the meaning as defined in Section "Introduction".

"INDEX COMPONENT" is each security reflected in the INDEX.

"INDEX CURRENCY" is the currency specified in the column "Currency" in the table in Section 1.2.

"LIVE DATE" shall have the meaning as defined in Section 1.3.

"INDEX COMMITTEE" shall have the meaning as defined in Section 3.5.

"SOLACTIVE" shall have the meaning as defined in Section "Introduction".

"Index START DATE" shall have the meaning as defined in Section 1.3.
