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INTRODUCTION

This document (the "Guideline") is to be used as a guideline with regard to the composition, calculation and maintenance of the Solactive Kaiko Ripple London Close EUR Index (the "INDEX"). Any amendments to the rules made to the Guideline are approved by the INDEX COMMITTEE specified in Section 4.5. The INDEX is owned, calculated, maintained, administered and published by Solactive AG ("Solactive") assuming the role of index administrator (the "INDEX ADMINISTRATOR") under the Regulation (EU) 2016/1011 (the "BENCHMARK REGULATION" or "BMR"). The name "Solactive" is trademarked.

The INDEX ADMINISTRATOR owns the copyright and all other intellectual property rights in the INDEX. Any use of these intellectual property rights may only be made with the prior written consent of the INDEX ADMINISTRATOR.

In no event shall the INDEX ADMINISTRATOR be liable (whether directly or indirectly, in contract, tort or otherwise) for any loss incurred by any person that arises out of or in connection with the INDEX, including in relation to the performance by the INDEX ADMINISTRATOR of any part of its role in respect of the INDEX, save in the case of gross negligence, fraud or wilful default. 1. INDEX SPECIFICATIONS

1.1. SCOPE OF THE INDEX

The INDEX is EUR denominated, aimed at tracking the rate of the INDEX COMPONENT, which is an index calculated by Kaiko that tracks the daily reference rate of Ripple as of 4 pm, London time.

1.2. IDENTIFIERS AND DISSEMINATION

The INDEX is published under the following identifiers:

The INDEX is published via the price marketing services of Boerse Stuttgart GmbH and may be distributed to all of its affiliated vendors. Each vendor decides on an individual basis as to whether it will distribute or display the INDEX via its information systems. In the event that data cannot be provided to the price marketing services of Boerse Stuttgart GmbH, the INDEX cannot be published.

1.3. INITIAL LEVEL OF THE INDEX

The initial level of the INDEX on 2023-05-19, the START DATE, is 0.44. Index values from 2025-09-29, the Live Date, will be recorded in accordance with Article 8 of the BMR. Levels of the INDEX published for a period prior to the Live Date have been backtested.

1.4. PRICES AND CALCULATION FREQUENCY

The level of the Index is calculated on each Calculation Day at Index Calculation Time based on the Closing Price for the Index Component.

If there is no current Closing Price for the Index Component in respect of a Calculation Day, the most recent Closing Price in respect of such Index Component is used in the calculation. The Closing Price of Index Component not listed in the Index Currency is converted using the 4:00 pm London time WM Fixing quoted by Reuters. If there is no 4:00 pm London time WM Fixing for the relevant Calculation Day, the last available 4:00 pm London time WM Fixing will be used for the closing level calculation.



1.5. LICENSING

Licenses to use the INDEX as the underlying value for financial instruments, investment funds and financial contracts may be issued to stock exchanges, banks, financial services providers, and investment houses by Solactive.



2. INDEX SELECTION

As this INDEX is based on a single underlying, no selection takes place.

2.1. INDEX UNIVERSE REQUIREMENTS

Not applicable as no ordinary rebalance takes place.

2.2. INDEX CONSTITUENTS

The INDEX consists of the following underlying component (the "INDEX COMPONENT"):

3. CALCULATION OF THE INDEX

3.1. INDEX FORMULA

The index level for any Calculation Day t, denoted $Index_Level_t$, is determined in accordance with the following formula:

 $Index_Level_t = UnderlyingIndex_t * FX_t$

Where:

 $UnderlyingIndex_t$ refers to the Closing Price of the Index Component, as of Calculation Day t

 FX_t : The 4:00 pm London time WMCO foreign exchange rate (mid-price) to convert one unit of USD to EUR as of CALCULATION DAY t.

3.2. ACCURACY

The level of the INDEX will be rounded to 2 decimal places.

3.3. RECALCULATION

Solactive makes the greatest possible efforts to accurately calculate and maintain its indices. However, errors in the determination process may occur from time to time for a variety of reasons (internal or external) and therefore cannot be completely ruled out. Solactive endeavors to correct all errors that have been identified within a reasonable period. The understanding of "a reasonable period of time" as well as the general measures to be taken are generally depending on the underlying and is specified in the Solactive Correction Policy, which is incorporated by reference and available on the Solactive website: https://www.solactive.com/documents/correction-policy/.

Additionally, the INDEX CONSULTANT adheres to its publicly available Data Corruption Procedure, which is incorporated by reference and available on the INDEX CONSULTANT website: Kaiko Indices Resources - Kaiko.

3.4. MARKET DISRUPTION

In periods of market disruptions, the INDEX CONSULTANT calculates its indices following predefined and exhaustive arrangements set out in its publicly available Market Events Procedure: Kaiko Indices Resources - Kaiko.



4. MISCELLANEOUS

4.1. DISCRETION

Any discretion which may need to be made in relation to the determination of the INDEX (for example the selection of the INDEX COMPONENTS (if applicable) or any other relevant decisions in relation to the INDEX) shall be made in accordance with strict rules regarding the exercise of discretion or expert judgement.

4.2. METHODOLOGY REVIEW

The methodology of the Index is subject to regular review. In case a need of a change of the methodology has been identified within such review (e.g. if the underlying market or economic reality has changed since the launch of the Index, i.e. if the present methodology is based on obsolete assumptions and factors and no longer reflects the reality as accurately, reliably and appropriately as before), such change will be made in accordance with the Methodology Policy, which is incorporated by reference and available on the Solactive website: www.solactive.com.

Such change in the Methodology will be announced on the Solactive webpage under the section "Announcement", which is available at https://www.solactive.com/news/announcements/. The date of the last amendment of this Index is contained in this Guideline.

4.3. CHANGES IN CALCULATION METHOD

The application by the INDEX ADMINISTRATOR of the method described in this document is final and binding. The INDEX ADMINISTRATOR shall apply the method described above for the composition and calculation of the INDEX. However, it cannot be excluded that the market environment, supervisory, legal and financial or tax reasons may require changes to be made to this method. The INDEX ADMINISTRATOR may also make changes to the terms and conditions of the INDEX and the method applied to calculate the INDEX that it deems to be necessary and desirable to prevent obvious or demonstrable error or to remedy, correct or supplement incorrect terms and conditions. The INDEX ADMINISTRATOR is not obliged to provide information on any such modifications or changes. Despite the modifications and changes, the INDEX ADMINISTRATOR will take the appropriate steps to ensure a calculation method is applied that is consistent with the method described above.

4.4. TERMINATION

Solactive makes the greatest possible efforts to ensure the resilience and continued integrity of its indices over time. Where necessary, Solactive follows a clearly defined and transparent procedure to adapt index methodologies to changing underlying markets (see Section 5.2 "Methodology Review") to maintain continued reliability and comparability of the indices. Nevertheless, if no other options are available the orderly cessation of an index may be indicated. This is usually the case



when the underlying market or economic reality, which an index is set to measure or to reflect, changes substantially and in a way not foreseeable at the time of inception of the index, the index rules, and particularly the selection criteria, can no longer be applied coherently or the index is no longer used as the underlying value for financial instruments, investment funds and financial contracts.

Solactive has established and maintains clear guidelines on how to identify situations in which the cessation of an index is unavoidable, how stakeholders are to be informed and consulted and the procedures to be followed for a termination or the transition to an alternative index. 4.5. INDEX COMMITTEE

An index committee composed of staff from Solactive and its subsidiaries (the "INDEX COMMITTEE") is responsible for decisions regarding any amendments to the rules of the INDEX. Any such amendment, which may result in an amendment of the Guideline, must be submitted to the INDEX COMMITTEE for prior approval and will be made in compliance with the Methodology Policy, which is available on the Solactive website: https://www.solactive.com/documents/methodology-policy/.



5. DEFINITIONS

"CALCULATION DAY" is any weekday which does not fall on 24th, 25th and 31st of December and on 1st of January each year.

"CLOSING PRICE" in respect of the INDEX COMPONENT and CALCULATION DAY is the daily rate of the INDEX COMPONENT, calculated by taking the last real-time reference rate value before 4 pm London time.

"GUIDELINE" shall have the meaning as defined in Section "Introduction".

"INDEX" shall have the meaning as defined in Section "Introduction".

"INDEX COMPONENT" shall have the meaning as defined in Section 2.

"INDEX CONSULTANT" shall have the meaning as defined in Section "Introduction".

"INDEX CURRENCY" is the currency specified in the column "Currency" in the table in Section 1.1.

"INDEX CALCULATION TIME" is 16:10h London Time.

"LIVE DATE" shall have the meaning as defined in Section 1.3.

"INDEX COMMITTEE" shall have the meaning as defined in Section 4.5.

"SOLACTIVE" shall have the meaning as defined in Section "Introduction.

"START DATE" shall have the meaning as defined in Section 1.3.



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
