List of environmental factors considered	Selection of the index components takes into account a scoring which is among other things based on the 26 SASB categories (Sustainability Ac- counting Standards Board). The top 200 stocks according to this score are eligibile for the index
List of social factors considered	Selection of the index components takes into account a scoring which is among other things based on the 26 SASB categories (Sustainability Ac- counting Standards Board). The top 200 stocks according to this score are eligibile for the index
List of governance factors considered	Selection of the index components takes into account a scoring which is among other things based on the 26 SASB categories (Sustainability Ac- counting Standards Board). The top 200 stocks according to this score are eligibile for the index.

The data provider has established processes in accordance with accepted and established market standards that ensure the permanent quality and reliability of the ESG-data provided.
