

# EXPLANATION OF HOW KEY ELEMENTS OF THE BENCHMARK METHODOLOGY REFLECT ENVIRONMENTAL, SOCIAL, AND GOVERNANCE (ESG) FACTORS

## ESG Factors Applied in the Benchmark Methodology

| List of environmental factors considered | > A company's overall ESGPerformanceScore of a company is used in the selection of index components, A company's CarbonRiskRating is used in the selection of index components, Exclusion of companies generating revenues (in proportion to their total revenues) >=5% from owning / operating nuclear power stations (generation of nuclear energy), >=10% from reselling electricity generated from nuclear power plant owned / operated by a third party, or >=10% from the production of major nuclear parts or providing major nuclear services (including nuclear power reactors, nuclear fuels, control rooms and waste storage), Exclusion of companies owning or operating uranium mines, Exclusion of companies causing severe environmental damage (based on Minerva Analytics UNGC assessment), Exclusion of companies involved in thermal coal mining activities, production of tar sand or oil shale, Exclusion of companies involved in thermal coal mining activities or tar sand or oil shale production., Exclusion of companies from the utilities industry with a carbon intensity of the electric power generated >= 315g CO2/kWh, Exclusion of companies violating the (environmental) principles of the UN Global Comact |
