List of environmental factors considered	 Exclusion of Companies without an "advanced" Protection of Biodiversity-Score (meaning a score higher than 60 following Vigeo Eiris classification) or a "robust" Protection of Biodiversity-Score (meaning a score higher than 50 following Vigeo Eiris classification) plus a contribution to Sustainable Goods and Services (SGS) connected to biodiversity (such as biobased chemicals, recycling services, rainwater harvesting, water quality preservation, waste treatment etc.). Exclusion of companies without a formalized commitment towards biodi-
	versity protection (meaning a commitment to Biodiversity question score of at least 2). Exclusion of companies with controversies on biodiversity.
List of social factors considered	Exclusion of companies involved in the mistreatment of animals (animal testing, medical research, fur and intensive farming). Exclusions of companies involved in genetically modified organisms.
